# FEELING COWL & BEANIE

## MATERIALS

### COWL

- 3 50g balls of Lana Gatto **FEELING** shade #12504 Grey.
- One pair size US 9 [5.5mm] needles or size to obtain gauge.
- Tapestry needle with rounded point.

### BEANIE

- 2 50g balls of Lana Gatto **FEELING** shade #12504 Grey.
- One size US 4 [3.5mm] circular needle or size to obtain gauge.
- Tapestry needle with rounded point.
- A *lace-and-fur* flower with a pin on the back.

## STITCHES

### USING KNITTING NEEDLES:

#### Broken Rib [work over odd sts]

Row 1 [RS]: Knit all sts.

Row 2: K2, P1, \* K1, P1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, K2.

Rep these 2 rows throughout.

### USING CIRCULAR NEEDLE:

#### 1x1 Rib [in the round]

Rnd 1: \* K1, P1; rep from \* to end.

Rnd 2 and following rnds: \* knit the K st and purl the P st; rep from \* to end.

#### Garter stitch [in the round]

Rnd 1: K all sts.

Rnd 2: P all sts.

Rep these 2 rnds for Garter st.

#### Seed stitch [over an even number of sts]

Rnd 1: \*P1, K1; rep from \* all around to end.

Rnd 2: K the purl sts and P the knit sts.

Rep rnd 2 for Seed st.

### USING TAPESTRY NEEDLE:

#### Whip-stitch

## GAUGE

### COWL

15 sts and 22 rows to 4in/10cm over Broken Rib, with 2 strands held together, using size US 9 [5.5mm] needles.

### BEANIE

20 sts and 34 rows to 4in/10cm over Seed st, using size US 4 [3.5mm] needle.

## NOTE!

FOR COWL: work with 2 strands of yarn held together throughout.

## ABBREVIATIONS

## COWL

With size US 9 [5.5mm] needles and 2 strands of yarn held tog throughout, cast on 43 sts. Work in Broken Rib until piece measures 33in/84cm from beg. Bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

With tapestry needle, sew side seam joining in Whip-stitch the first 33 cast-on sts to left side [RS of work] of last 48 rows [approx 8½in/21.5cm seam.]

## BEANIE

With size US 4 [3.5mm] circular needle, cast on 100 sts. Work 12 rnds in 1x1 Rib for brim [approx 1½in/4cm], then cont in Seed st increasing 10 sts evenly around 1st rnd. There are 110 sts. When work measures 6¼in/16cm from brim, cont in Garter st, dec 20 sts evenly around 1st rnd [90 sts rem], then dec 15 sts evenly around every alternate rnd twice [60 sts rem] and dec 10 sts evenly around every alternate rnd 4 times [20 sts rem.] Cut yarn leaving a long tail and, using tapestry needle, draw through rem sts. Pull yarn and fasten off.

## FINISHING

Pin a *lace-and-fur* flower at top of slouchy beanie
