US 6, 9, 11 needle

Instructions

This wrap pattern is a great introduction to lace for an advanced beginner knitter. By changing the needle size to create shaping as well as added drape, this piece becomes an elegant, sophisticated wrap with tons of versatility! You will enjoy knitting it as well as wearing it!

You may place a marker 6 stitches in from both edges to maintain the garter stitch border.

SET UP

Using size 11 needles, cast on 84 st
k6, PM, work 8 repeats of lace pattern, PM, , k6
Wrong side rows are all k6, SM, purl 72, SM, k6

Continuing with US 11 needle, work lace chart a total of 12 times through.
Switch to US 9 needle, work lace chart 10 times.
Switch to US 6 needle, work lace chart 5 times.
Switch to US 9 needle, work lace chart 10 times.
Switch to US 11 needle, work through lace chart 12 times.

Lace Pattern

Row 1: k2, k2-tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2

Row 2: purl

Row 3: k1, k2-tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1

Row 4: purl

Row 5: k2-tog, yo, k5, yo, ssk

Row 6: purl

These 6 rows form the lace pattern.

Abbreviations

— or K	Knit on right side, purl on wrong side
or P	Purl on right side, knit on wrong side
PM	Place Marker
SM	Slip Marker
M1	Lift bar between two stitches and knit through the back loop
○ yo	yarn over
◐ Kfb	Knit into front and back of next stitch
▶ or K2tog	Knit 2 stitches together through front loop
◑ p2tog	Purl 2 stitches together through front loop
◐ or SSK	Slip 1 knit-wise, slip 1 knit-wise; knit those two slipped stitches together
◑	Repeat stitches outlined in red
